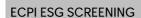

ECPI ESG Rating is a synthetic measure of these performances, based on a set of indicators defined by the ECPI ESG Rating Methodology. The ECPI Rating scale goes from F (Ineligible) to EEE, with EEE being the highest grade.

Stocks belong to the BICS sectors connected with: oncology, neuroscience, cardiology, science and education, healthy nutrition, longevity. Sector Exclusion: no tobacco, alcoholic beverages, animal slaughtering, junk food, soft drinks

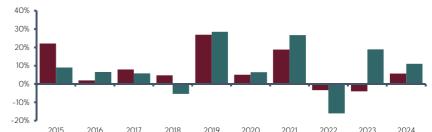

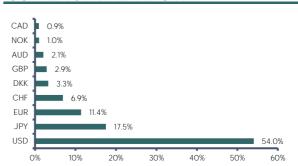

# **COUNTRY BREAKDOWN**



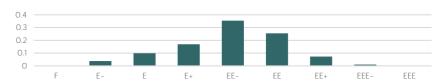
